### *Exciting Changes Happening at the Museum!*

At our all-hands meeting on Thursday evening, our Executive Director, Elissa Lines, talked through some of the changes that have been made in our transition so far. We have a new director of Exhibits, Restoration, and Curatorial Services, Rod Bengston. Rod comes to us with decades of museum experience, most recently as the Director of the John Young Museum of Art at UH Manoa.

Rod has put together a proposal for updating Hangar 37 to better tell our stories. Hangar 37 will illustrate the story of December 7th, 1941 by displaying the attackers and the defenders. The Kate will be displayed next to the Zero, we will have a new attack map on the wall, and there will be some additional changes coming. These are all positive, exciting developments and I look forward to seeing how our visitors' experiences will improve as they are implemented.
